Shabda Kahn is a direct disciple of the American Sufi Master, Murshid Samuel Lewis and has been practicing Sufism since 1969. Shabda is the Pir (Spiritual Director) of the Sufi Ruhaniat International, the Sufi lineage in the stream of Hazrat Inayat Khan and Murshid Samuel Lewis. He has also studied and performed North Indian Classical Vocal Music under the guidance of the late Master Singer, Pandit Pran Nath, since 1972. He leads retreats and camps in Sufism with an emphasis on the Mysticism of Breath, the Science and Art of Wazifa and Zikr, Music, the Walking Practices inspired by Murshid Samuel Lewis and opening the Heart. He brings humor and gentleness in his efforts to transmit the rich lineage of Sufism. The weekend retreat will emphasize integration of the Sublime with everyday life, incorporating many of the Sufi practices.
