Pir Shabda Kahn

Shabda Kahn is a direct disciple of the American Sufi Master Murshid Samuel Lewis and has been practicing Sufism since 1969. He is the pir (spiritual director) of the Sufi Ruhaniat International, the sufi lineage tracing from Hazrat Inayat Khan and Murshid Samuel Lewis. In 1972 Shabda met his second great teacher, the late master singer, Pandit Pran Nath, and began the daily practice of North Indian classical vocal music. Shabda is also a disciple of the illustrious Tibetan Buddhist Master, the 12th Tai Situpa Rinpoche.

He leads retreats and camps in Sufism with an emphasis on the mysticism of breath; the science and art of wazifa and zikr; music; the walking practices inspired by Murshid Samuel Lewis; and opening the heart. He brings humor and gentleness in his efforts to transmit the rich lineage of Sufism.
