**The Program** • We will depart the U.S. for India Jan 31, 2012, arriving late night Feb 1st. Our group activities will be complete on February 11, 2012 evening. We expect participants from all over the globe, all arriving in time to begin Thursday morning, February 2, 2012. Throughout the program there will be morning raga classes, Sufi teachings with Taj Inayat, Dances of Universal Peace and zikr.

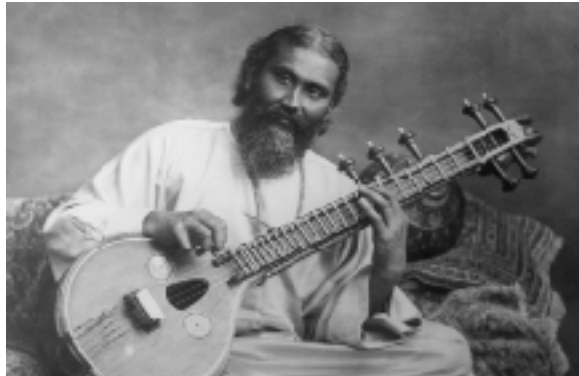
We will participate in all Urs activities, including Indian Music performances, Qawali music, the Urs day, and presentations by Pir Zia Inayat Khan, other Sufi leaders and many local Sufi pirs.

We hope to have the blessing of receiving teachings from the 12th Tai Situpa Rinpoche.

Outings in Delhi include visits to the shrines of Hazrat Inayat Khan, Hazrat Nizamuddin Aulia, Hazrat Amir Khusrau, Hazrat Qutbuddin Baktiar Kaki (the 2nd in the Chisti lineage after Hazrat Moinuddin Chisti Ajmeri), Hazrat Bibi Fatima, as well as Humayun's Tomb — the precursor to the Taj Mahal. The pilgrimage will culminate with a journey to Ajmer and the Dargah of our lineage founder Khwaja Moinuddin Chisti.

**Accommodations** • American-style guest house located in a quiet neighborhood minutes from the center of New Delhi and the Dargah of Hazrat Inayat Khan. Delicious buffet-style brunch and dinner are included. Meals are specially prepared for us and include healthy vegetarian and non-vegetarian entrees.

Tuition includes all activities, outings, and travel in India, double occupancy room, and meals. Private rooms are available for an additional \$650 (450€) on a space-available basis.
